TITLE	RALLYUP INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS
<p>Bronze – Level 1 BR1</p> <p>Bronze – Level 2 BR2</p> <p>Bronze – Excellence BRX</p>	<p>A RallyUp Bronze Level 1 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a bronze course. All four (4) qualifying scores can be earned on leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Bronze Level 2 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a bronze course. Three (3) qualifying scores can be earned on leash, one (1) qualifying score must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Bronze Excellence title requires ten (10) qualifying scores on a bronze course after the completion of a Bronze title (the 4 scores earned for the title will be applied to the requirement of 10). The remaining qualifying scores earned after the title must be earned on bronze courses off leash. A Bronze qualifying score is 170 – 200 points.</p>
<p>Silver – Level 1 S1</p> <p>Silver – Level 2 S2</p> <p>Silver – Excellence SX</p>	<p>A RallyUp Silver Level 1 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a silver course. Two (2) qualifying scores can be earned on leash, two (2) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Silver Level 2 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a silver course. One (1) qualifying scores can be earned on leash, three (3) qualifying score must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Silver Excellence title requires ten (10) qualifying scores on a silver course after the completion of a Silver title (the 4 scores earned for the title will be applied to the requirement of 10). The remaining qualifying scores earned after the title must be earned on silver courses off leash. A Silver qualifying score is 175 – 200 points.</p>
<p>Gold – Level 1 G1</p> <p>Gold – Level 2 G2</p> <p>Gold – Excellence GX</p>	<p>A RallyUp Gold Level 1 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a gold course. Two (2) qualifying score can be earned on leash, two (2) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Gold Level 2 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a gold course. All four (4) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RallyUp Gold Excellence title requires ten (10) qualifying scores on a gold course after the completion of a Gold title (the 4 scores earned for the title will be applied to the requirement of 10). The remaining qualifying scores earned after the title must be earned on gold courses off leash. A Gold qualifying score is 180 – 200 points.</p>
<p>Platinum PX</p>	<p>A RallyUp Platinum title requires a combination of two (2) bronze qualifying scores, three (3) silver qualifying scores, and five (5) gold qualifying scores. All qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p>

TITLE	RALAGILITY INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS
<p>Bronze – Level 1 RAL BR1</p> <p>Bronze – Level 2 RAL BR2</p> <p>Bronze – Excellence RAL BRX</p>	<p>A RalAgility Bronze Level 1 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a bronze course. Two (2) qualifying scores can be earned on leash, two (2) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RalAgility Silver Level 2 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a silver course. One (1) qualifying scores can be earned on leash, three (3) qualifying score must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RalAgility Silver Excellence title requires ten (10) qualifying scores on a silver course after the completion of a Silver title (the 4 scores earned for the title will be applied to the requirement of 10). Two (2) qualifying score can be earned on leash, two (2) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RalAgility Gold Level 2 title requires four (4) qualifying scores on a gold course. All four (4) qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p> <p>A RalAgility Gold Excellence title requires ten (10) qualifying scores on a gold course after the completion of a Gold title (the 4 scores earned for the title will be applied to the requirement of 10). The remaining qualifying scores earned after the title must be earned on gold courses off leash. A Gold qualifying score is 180 – 200 points.</p>
<p>Platinum RAL PX</p>	<p>A RalAgility Platinum title requires a combination of two (2) bronze qualifying scores, three (3) silver qualifying scores, and five (5) gold qualifying scores. All qualifying scores must be earned off leash.</p>
TITLE	PARTNER REQUIREMENTS
<p>Requirements for Partner titles are the same for individual titles. A “P” is added to the title level to signify Partner. Partners must agree prior to entering ring if performance will be on leash or off leash; both partners must adhere to the decision. The Partner station honor will always be performed on leash.</p>	
TITLE	JUNIOR & SENIOR REQUIREMENTS
<p>Requirements for Junior Handler titles and Senior Handler titles are the same for individual titles. A “JR” is added to the title level to signify Junior Handler. An “SR” is added to the title level to signify Senior Handler. Junior Handlers and Senior Handlers perform same course requirements as all other handlers during the trial. Only prize awards and titles are separated.</p>
